Nico O'Reilly delivered a disciplined and technically assured performance in a high-intensity European fixture at the Santiago Bernabéu. Operating in central midfield against elite opposition, he showed maturity in possession, composure under pressure, and a strong understanding of positional play. Despite City facing sustained spells without the ball, O'Reilly remained tactically reliable, contributing to ball progression and defensive stability in midfield zones.

His display reflected a player capable of adapting to top-level European tempo, even in a demanding away environment.

His spatial awareness allowed City to maintain structure even under prolonged pressure phases.
