Ben White had a mixed outing in his hybrid right-back role. While he maintained composure in possession and provided numerical support in the build-up, defensive lapses contributed to conceding twice. Intelligent positioning was evident, but transition moments exposed vulnerabilities.

■ Key Takeaways

Composed in Build-Up:

- 89% pass accuracy, 9 progressive passes.
- Calm under pressure though a few interceptions led to counters.

Positionally Smart:

- Linked play in central zones, active between Zones 2 & 3.
- Occasional misalignment left the right channel exposed.

Defensive Challenges:

- 5 interceptions, 2 errors contributing to goals.
- Struggled during quick transitions.

Tactical Awareness:

- Smart tactical foul to stop a dangerous counter.

■ Tactical Role Fit

Played as an inverted full-back in a 4-2-3-1, acting as a pivot in midfield during possession.

Strength: Helps structure buildup centrally.

Weakness: Vulnerable on counters targeting the right channel.

Trajectory: Slight dip due to defensive lapses.

Projection: Remains a high-value inverted RB/CM hybrid.

■ Tactical Fit & Suitability
